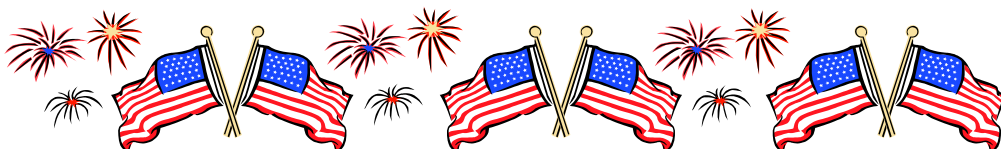

We are excited to host the 3rd Annual Cedar Chapel Swim Competition that will be held on Friday May, 6th. Please join us as students compete for awards.

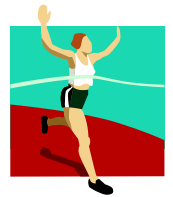
## Spring Games:

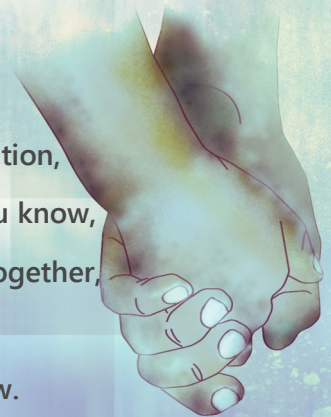

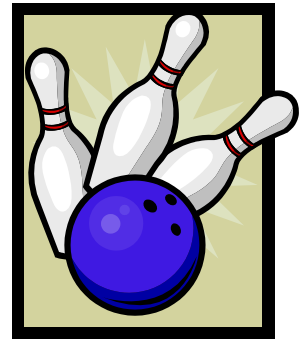

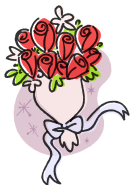
