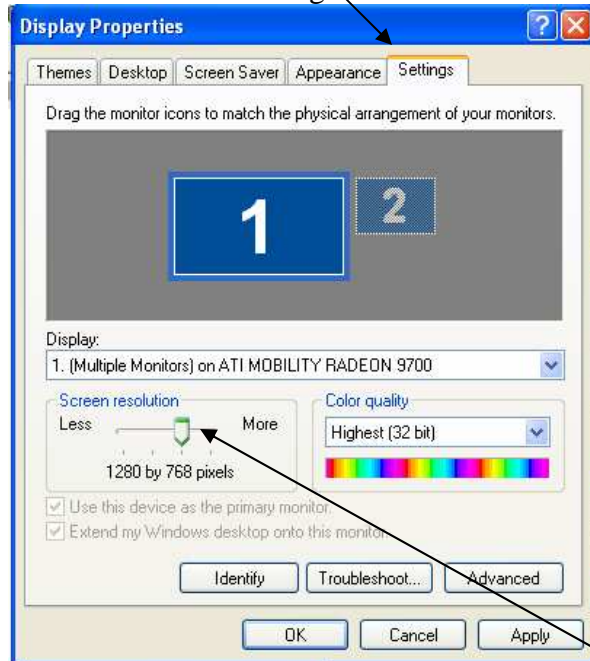


## Optimal Website Viewing Tips:

A. For optimal viewing, it is best to set your display resolution to 1280 by at least 768 pixels. To check and change your computer's resolution, please follow the steps below:

1. Click on your "Start" button, usually located on the bottom left-hand corner of your monitor or display screen.
2. Click on "Control Panel."
3. Double click on your "Display" icon or graphic.
4. Click on the "Settings" tab.



5. If resolution needs to be adjusted, move the bar (by left clicking and dragging) to obtain a screen resolution quality of 1280 by at least 768 pixels.
6. If you have changed your screen resolution, click "Apply," followed by "OK."
7. Review the website at the new resolution. You should be able to see the entire width of the website on your screen.

B. To further enhance viewing, the font size should be "medium." To check or change your font size, please follow the steps below:

1. Open the [www.worcesterk12.com](http://www.worcesterk12.com) website.
2. Click on "View," located on the top tool bar.
3. Scroll down to "Text Size" and over and down to "medium."
4. Release cursor to select medium. (*See below*)



**NOTE:** If you have reset the resolution, and you wish to keep a larger font size, select “large,” instead of “medium.” The result, although not optimal, will result in a very good display of the website.
